Who to trust and who to cuddle.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I can explain why we need privacy in the toilet - I can say if I have a penis or a vulva - I can say who is okay to cuddle and who is not. <p>(PANTS) non optional</p>
Year 2 - Summer 2	<p>Growing and changing. Naming parts of the human body. Correct names for body parts including genitalia.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I can name my body parts including my genitalia
