## Uniform at Berger Primary School

Our school uniform is an important part of life at Berger. As a school we see our diversity as a source of strength and pride and our uniform as an aspect of Berger which brings everyone at Berger together. We also believe that by wearing the correct uniform our children are showing that they have come to school prepared to learn and meet our high expectations.

We expect all children to wear:


A Berger jumper.
Either grey trousers, a grey skirt or grey shorts.


A white polo shirt for children in Reception only.


A white shirt with a collar. Can be long or short sleeved for KS1 and KS2.


Black shoes with a heel strap and covered toes. Black trainers are permissible but they must have a black sole and no visible logos.


A school PE shirt and grey or black shorts or track suit bottoms

## Uniform Code

Please note that Ties are no longer part of Berger Primary School uniform policy
No jewellery of any description is allowed to be worn by any child. The only exception to this rule are 'stud earrings'.
No open-end footwear, such as Sandals, are allowed to be worn.

## Nursery -

Not required to wear school uniform

## Reception -

- White Polo-neck T shirts
- School Jumper (brought from school)
- Black/Grey Trousers/ Skirts (Red or Blue Dresses are allowed during Summer Term- see photos)

Black footwear - Shoes are preferred but plain black trainers without company logos are acceptable.

## KS1 \& KS2

- White collar long sleeved shirts (short sleeved in Summer term)
- School jumper (brought from school)
- Black/Grey Trousers/ Skirts (Red or Blue Dresses are allowed during Summer Term- see photos)
- Black footwear - Shoes are preferred but plain black trainers without company logos are acceptable.
PE Kit
- House coloured PE top (brought from school)
- Shorts/ Skirt
- PE footwear

Notes: During the summer term children may wear blue or red gingham dresses. In exceptionally hot weather the school will notify parents and carers to inform them that jumpers are not expected.

Headscarves must be free of design and either blue, white or grey.

School jumpers and PE are available to buy at the school office.
Please make sure all pieces of the uniform are named.
If your child does not have the correct uniform on a Class Dojo message will be sent reminding you of the school's expectations and requesting that the correct uniform is worn. If the correct uniform is not worn the following day your child will be given a playtime detention.
